


CAMP RULES!! YES, IT DOES!!

And here are some we need to follow...

The Salvation Army requires that the Dancing Bears Dance Camp Community abide by the following rules:

- Keep King's Lake Camp facilities and buildings alcohol-free and drug-free.
- Maintain a primarily a tobacco-free and smoke-free environment...no smoking in the cabins.
- The speed limit is 5 MPH on the Camp Road.
- Do not drive beyond the gates.
- No parking is allowed at the cabins. Cars are to be parked in the designated parking area only.
- Fire lanes cannot be blocked at any time.
- The use of firearms, BB guns, slingshots, bows & arrows (anything that shoots projectiles) and fireworks is prohibited. Don't bring them.
- PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN CAMP, not even in your car or RV. If you bring a pet to Camp you will have to take it back home.
- Don't harass the wildlife.
-  All cabin users will sweep and clean their cabins prior to leaving.



The Dancing Bears have a few, too...

- Campers must register their cabin or tent location to ensure that they can be notified in case of any emergency situation.
- Any water activity, such as swimming or boating, is done at the individual's own risk. For safety reasons, PFDs (Personal flotation devices) are required for EVERYONE who plays on/in the lake.
- Parents are responsible for their children at all times.
